

## ComEd Facility Relocation in Your Area

Dear Valued Customer:

To facilitate the installation of a new sewer project, to be completed by the Village of Wilmette, ComEd will be relocating our existing underground cable along Hunter Ave. between Chestnut and Elmwood, during the next few weeks.

### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

On Monday February 14<sup>th</sup>, ComEd contractors will begin work installing new underground cable via direct boring, drilling below grade from entry to exit pits. Construction vehicles will be working in the area and may require access at critical locations, and at times, may be blocking street parking, alleys and occasionally traffic lanes. The manner and duration of blockings will be determined by the needs of the project at any given location. This work is scheduled to be completed approximately February 25<sup>th</sup>.

No power outages will be required for this work.

### **RESTORING YOUR PROPERTY**

ComEd expects this work to cause minimal disruption to any customer property. In the unlikely event that we do cause any damage, we will return once the work has been completed and restore any damaged landscaping to its previous condition. To ensure the best possible outcome, landscaping restoration work may be postponed until weather permits.
