



Notice of Nicor and ComEd Upgrades & Relocations Via Hand Delivery

Prior to the March 1st start of the Neighborhood Storage Project - Phase 3, Nicor and ComEd are working to upgrade, add or relocate gas and electric facilities in the neighborhood around Thornwood Park.

Nicor

Nicor began installing a new gas main on Beechwood, so that it will be completed prior to Phase 3 storm sewer work starting on March 1st. Impacted residents should have received a notice from Nicor explaining details about their work. After Beechwood, Nicor will continue with work on Washington, Hunter and Greenwood. No gas service outages are required except on the day that each new gas service will be connected to the new gas main. **Gas service transfers will be scheduled with you in advance by Nicor.** If you wish to have a Village staff member in attendance for the transfer, please call Lisa or Brigitte. ComEd

Over the next several weeks, ComEd will also be performing preparatory work in your neighborhood in advance of the stormwater project. The scope of work includes installing a new electric service line on Thornwood Avenue, electric cable relocations and relocating a pole at the corner of Hunter and Thornwood.

Sidewalk and Parkway Restoration

The Village will work with Nicor and ComEd to coordinate the appropriate method of restoration for any impacted sidewalks and parkways. Sidewalks and parkways that will be replaced in the ensuing weeks as part of the stormwater project will be made safe and accessible in the interim.
